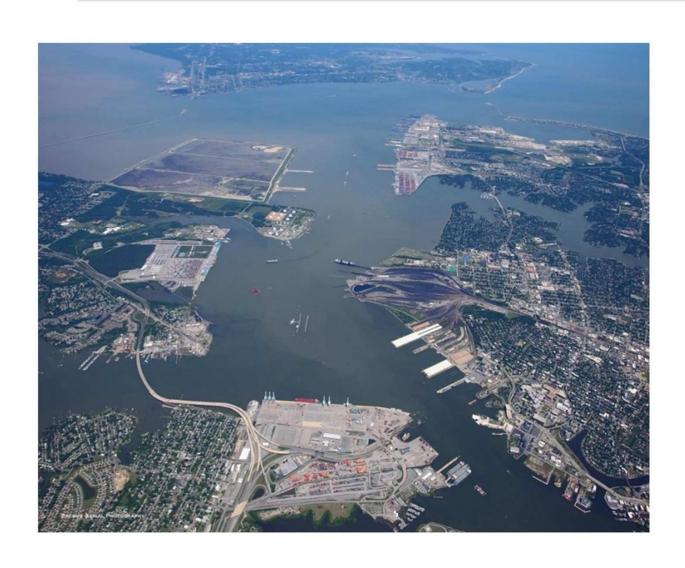

- Quality of Life

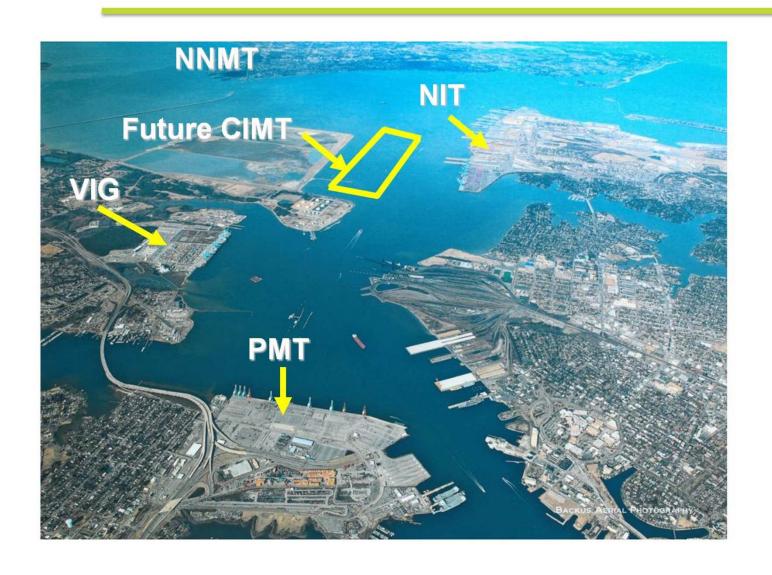
The Port of Virginia



Statewide Footprint

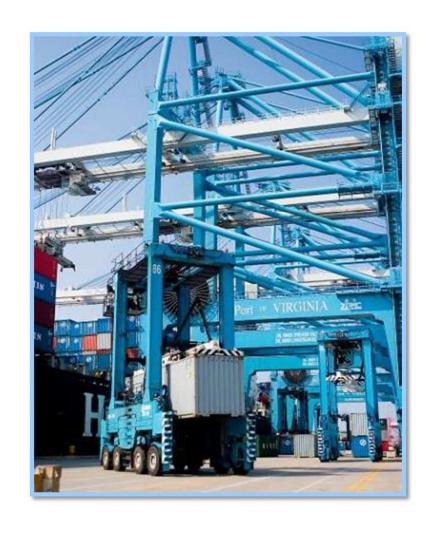


Hampton Roads Harbor



Port Activity over 2015

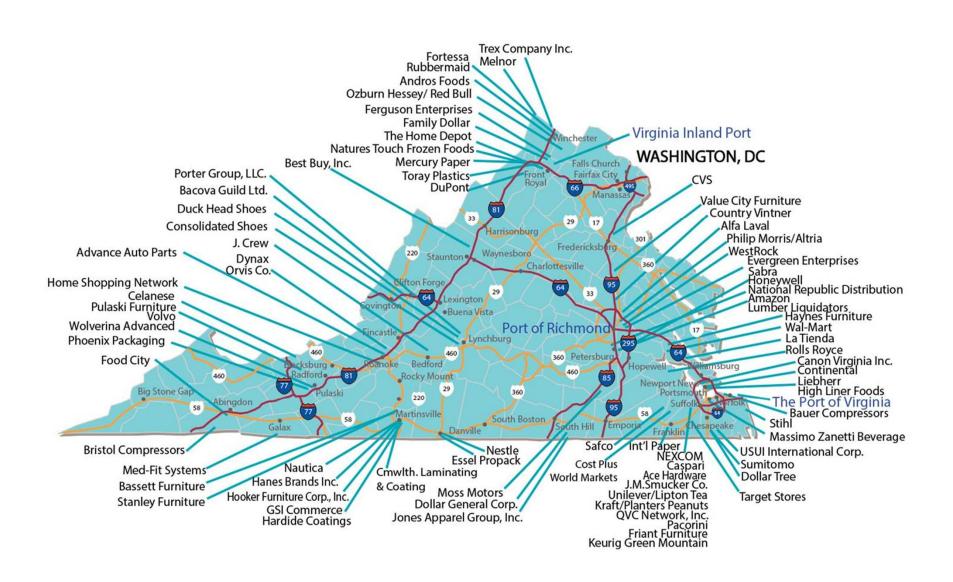
- Ranked as the 3rd largest port on the U.S. East Coast and the 6th largest port in the country in TEUs
- In 2015, The Port of Virginia handled 2.5 million TEUs, a 7% increase over 2014
- 2015 Trade Balance: 55% exports and 45% imports

Trends over 2015

Residential

- New Construction Permits (+13.5%)
- Resale sales (+8.2%)
- Median Sales Price rose from \$196,000 to \$202,800, (+3.5%)

Multi-Family

- Homeownership rate decreased 2010-2015
- 63% are considered class A or class B units
- Vacancy rates dropped to 6%
- 3,200 units under construction with another 2,800 proposed

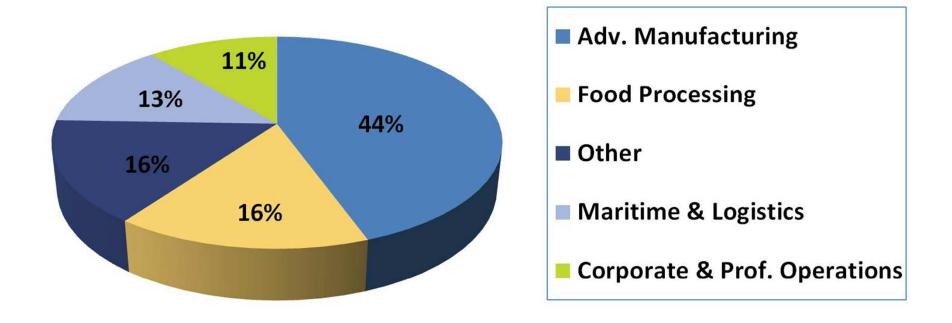

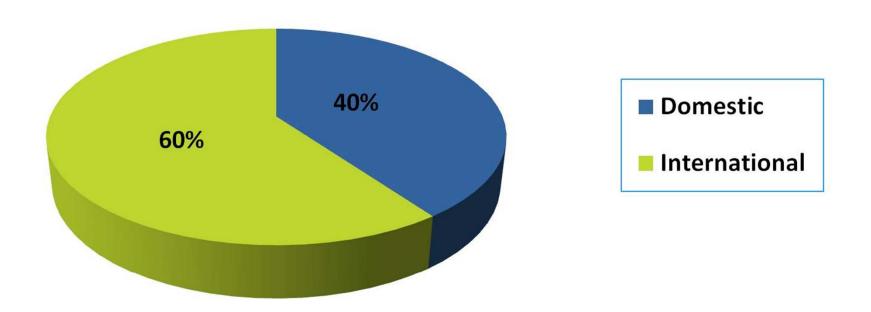

Looking Forward

2016

- The regional economy will continue to improve (+1.6% forecasted FY 2016)
 - increased consumer confidence, lower gas prices, declining local unemployment rate
- The Port, Healthcare, & Tourism are industries likely to help the region's moderate expansion in 2016
- Port volume is expected to increase through 2016
 - General Cargo Tonnage (+2.7%)
 - TEUs (+4.8%)
 - Panama Canal is close to completion
- Real Estate Markets
 - Single-family home prices are likely to continue to increase through 2016
 - Multi-Family development promises to have a record year
